**Job Descriptions:**

<b>Head Cook</b>	Knowledgeable of how to cook the meal and can teach others. Lead meal preparation in combination with the Assistant Cook(s). Clean the stove.
<b>Ass't Cook(s)</b>	Assist Head Cook in the meal preparation. Clean the stove.
<b>Head Clean-up</b>	Put wash and sterilization buckets on stove. Add soap. Clean patrol cooking equipment. Wash table(s), put away food and secure patrol boxes and food.
<b>Ass't Clean-up</b>	Put wash and sterilization buckets on stove. Add soap. Clean patrol cooking equipment. Wash table(s), put away food and secure patrol boxes and food.
<b>Swing Man</b>	Assistant Clean-up: See above. - OR - Assistant Cook: See above. Assigned by PL.
<b>Fire / Water</b>	Fire: Prepare wood and / or charcoal fires for cooking needs and maintain them as needed. Pre-heat Dutch ovens. Water: See that there is enough water for each meal. Fill water jugs or retrieve them from vehicle. Return jugs to patrol site. Fill 3 wash buckets.
